
Major Track Closure and Train Transfer - GO Trains Running on Elevated Guideway as of March 27

Friday March 24 at 23:00 - Monday March 27 at 04:00



Project Overview

The Davenport Diamond Guideway project supports Metrolinx's GO Expansion program, enabling two-way, all-day frequent service on the Barrie GO Line.

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

Track work and signals work for weekend train transfer, in the Metrolinx corridor, from 600m South of Bloor St to 300m north of Davenport Rd. Over the weekend, crews will tie the new west main line track into the existing main line track at the north and south limits of the project.

GO Trains will be running on the elevated guideway as of Monday, March 27, 2023

WHAT TO EXPECT

•Local residents can expect construction activity, excavation, noise, and lights. The work being performed will require heavy rail equipment and operating machinery (cranes, dozers, welders and grinders), and vibration. These disturbances can be expected at any time during the weekend including during the night. Starting Monday, March 27, GO Trains will run on the elevated guideway

•00:00 - 23:59

TRAFFIC DETAILS

•Saturday March 25, from 10:00 - 13:00: Single lane closure to occur on the north side of Wallace Avenue (east side of the track) to have the gate removed and turn the signal head, crews will then flip the south side of Wallace Avenue (west side of the track) to have the articulating gate removed and turn the signal head.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

•Wallace Ave articulating arms and lights removal - Saturday March 25, from 10:00 -13:00 - Pedestrians can expect to be detoured by personnel to opposite sidewalk on Wallace Avenue where work is not occurring

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- •Trains on the Barrie line will be replaced by GO buses on Saturday, March 25 until end of service Sunday, March 26.
- •Replacement buses will provide service between Union Station Bus Terminal, Rutherford, Maple, King City, Aurora, Newmarket and East Gwillimbury GO stations. Some bus trips will run express to Aurora GO so be sure to check schedules before you travel.
 •Replacement buses will not serve Downsview Park
- Replacement buses will not serve Downsview Park GO. You can use TTC or YRT to travel to and from this station.
- •Regular train service will resume Monday, March 27
